1. Correspondence: None
Maryville Park Donations – None
2. Khory League: Nothing official has been received from the Khoury League regarding season opening. This has previous taken place the first weekend in May.
3. Events Reports:
 - Master Gardeners – June 30, 2011 has been approved as the date for this years open gate event.
 - Discovery Serires –The birding event was the remaining program for this years discovery series. The event was attended by about 30 participants. The event went well and there has been a group formed from the event that has already had one event.
 - Movies – The movies for this years series were chosen. The movies will be in order – Dispicable Me, Secretariat, Toy Story 3 and Gnomeo & Juliet. Sharon will get information to Butch on securing the movies. Butch will contact the high schools to see if there is any interest in a student or faculty member running audio and video for these events.
 - Workday – The work day is scheduled for Saturday, April 16, 2011. We have 110 trees to be planted this year. Angel, Ryan & Sharon will get together and mark the placement of the trees. Sharon will contact Jill and Albert Walker to see if they can assist with this years event.

- Go Fly a Kite – Dennis & Angel will be hosting this years event. Dennis will contact Roger Shoup to information on supplies that may be available for this years event.
 - Bike Rodeo – Angel, Butch, Ryan & Dave will be available responsible for this years event. Angel will put together some details and report at next months meeting.
 - Concerts – Steve Brandes is booked for the Elvis concert this year. George Portz will be back again this year with the fiddlers frolic. The September date is open and we are stilling looking for a country band for this event.
4. Liaisons Comments:

5. Mayors Comments:
- There was extensive tree damage from the last storm throughout the park. Pavillion 1 was also damaged and repairs are scheduled to begin tomorrow. First Baptist Church helped to clean the damage from the storm.
 - We have not received the funding for the Fred Winters Park grant. Mayor Gulledge stated that the funding is still in place however we are still waiting to receive these funds.
 - We received a \$56,000 grant that will attach Route 159 to the Bike Trail. Bids for this project will go out once the grant has been funded.
6. Old Business:
- Ryan & Bob have gone out and walked Winters Park to become more familiar with the area.
 - Butch will get the group together after the work day to visit Noga Park.
7. New Business:
- Sharon suggested that several changes be made to the Pavillion Rental application. It was decided that the renatl fees for Pavillion 6&7 should be the same as rental fees for Pavillions 1&3. The group agreed and the changes will get made to the agreement to reflect these additions.
 - A discussion concerning bikes on the new trails in the park was conducted. It was concluded that we place this item on the agenda for discussion during next months meeting.
 - Butch was given sizes for all shirt sizes for the Park Committee. The order will be placed and the shirts should be available for next months meeting.
 - There was discussion concerning a dock by the Hex Pavillion. It was agreed that this should be a consideration in future plans.
