Meeting called to order at 6pm, members in attendance, Sharon Petty, Dennis Reynolds, Mike Vallino, Angel Merz, Judy Weimann, Carol Frerker, Bob Kilzer, Andrew Carruthers.

There were no meeting meetings available for approval as there was no July meeting.

Reports/Activities:

Craig Heating with Johnson Control presented a recommendation of a one day event for kayaking at Drost Park. The event would include boating safety prior to a kayaking demonstration then the opportunity for residents to pick a boat, they'd be set up with lifejackets and have a general orientation before being allowed to paddle around the lake. Craig has been involved with the Alpine Shop in Kirkwood and worked events with them in the past, however he is a member of W Water Assoc, American Canoe Associate and has swift water rescue certification and would be willing to handle the event with a group from his kayak club. This would help raise kayaking awareness in our area and this kind of event has never been done in Maryville. Board members were very interested in this idea. Craig will follow up to set something up on the calendar for next year.

There was discussion whether to eliminate one or two movies from the July/August schedule due to the heat and lower attendance at these movies. They have conflicted with Troy Homecoming and the suggestion was to move one out to Sept/Oct to beat the heat. All agreed this was a good idea. Next movie is 9/24, A Bug's Life. Larry & Todd reported they would be out of town and that someone needs to pick up equipment before the village office closes that day. There was discussion to pick newer movies for next year. Cost was discussed but members believe there are enough sponsors for this event that we shouldn't have issues covering event costs.

Nothing new on the to do list and no new donations to report. No correspondence.

Mayor's Comments:

Board approved \$38,000 to asphalt the parking lot and past first little pavilion on right where bike connectors are. He reported the Khoury League was very happy the the lights at the ball field. We talked about purchasing a tarp to cover the audio/video equipment used for movies in anticipation of rain to prevent damage to the equipment. He was also going to check on soccer nets as the nets are in bad shape again.

Larry also mentioned Cindy Winters with Grace & Hope Ministries will be hosting the first 5-10K walk or run to start from and return to fireman's park on 10/9/10 and hopes to make this an annual event.
