4. Mayors Comments:

Several residents were invited to attend a discussion regarding a grant that was received and will be used for the development of Fred Winters Park. The grant needs to be finalized by May 21, 2010. After a lengthy discussion, it was agreed

that the park will remain passive in nature as previously discussed. The following recommendation will be made to the Village Board:

***The committee would like to recommend the purchase of two (2) 16 foot hex shaped pavilions, four (4) picnic tables for placement in the pavilions (two in each pavilion), four (4) trash receptacles with lids, two (2) bike racks, two (2) barbeque pits, six (6) benches, two (2) glider type swings and one (1) playground type children's swing set. Other items were agreed to be purchased as funds are available at the descretion of Trustee Bell and Mayor Gulledge. These items will be consistent and complementary with the list above. The discretionary items will be selected by Gulledge and Bell not to exceed the grant amount since there were no bids available at the time of this meeting.***

The lights at the ball field are up and have been tested. They were used for one inning by the kids. Several finishing touches need to made. We are waiting for things to dry out just a bit before these can be completed.

The mayor has been in contact with several local organizations who have expressed an interest in sponsoring movies. These include Bobby's, Joe Seminisin, Maryville Pharmacy & Ron Motil.

The mayor has received an informal approval for the 2010 environmental grant. This grant includes 10 6' benches, 10 hex tables, 10 waste receptacles and 5 bike racks. All equipment in this grant is made from recycled materials.

The boat ramp is complete with the exception of the railing. The part had to be custom made and has been ordered. The part should be arrive in about a week.
