- Baseball/Softball Leagues JT Foyers attended to discuss about Baseball/Softball Leagues: Drost Park Khoury League is the old name. Now Called the Drost Park Baseball/Softball League. 350 kids that are currently playing it is 60% Collinsville/Maryville. They are trying to keep things running and looking off a local non-profit to keep concession stand running for the kids. The League consists of all kids above the age of kindergarten and currently co-op with Troy, IL. It is a bit chaotic and a scheduling nightmare. They struggle to get dirt to level the fields and are looking to hopefully spen \$5,000 on Turface to use on the fields for 2023. The restrooms need assistance with upkeep.
